Tardies will be marked for students that arrive after 7:50 AM. Gates will close at 7:50 AM. For Pre-K-8 if you arrive after 7:50 AM, your student will need to enter through McManus. For the safety of our students, please do not drop them off behind McManus after the gates are closed.

Early Release Procedures

All early release notes should be emailed to

and the student's homeroom teacher. K-8 students must be picked up before 2:30 PM in McManus. Pre-K students must be picked up before 2 PM in McManus.

Absence Notification

Regular attendance is an important component to the success of your child's school learning experience. Absences must be reported by email to attendance@stmonicaschool.org on or before 8:45 AM.

School Clinic Info

The clinic is located in C-wing near the playground.
Services provided by the clinic include first aid, managing medical emergencies, administration of prescribed medication, and monitoring ill students until a parent arrives to pick them up.

All forms can be found under the "Parents" tab and downloaded from the school website.

- Asthma Action Plan or Allergy Action Plan: If your child has Asthma or a severe Allergy (food, insects, etc.) an Asthma or Allergy Action Plan must be completed by your physician and submitted to the clinic along with the prescribed medication and the Medication Request Form.
- The Diocese of Dallas Health History
- Immunization Requirements for the current school year. The immunization record provided by your physician is an acceptable substitute. As required by the Texas Department of Health, immunizations must be current for your child to attend class.
- <u>Documenting History of Illness</u>: Varicella (Chickenpox) this form should be submitted only if your child had Chickenpox disease.
- <u>Medication Permit Form</u> This form is to be submitted if your child will be taking a prescription medication at school. This form requires both parent and physician signatures.

We can administer Over the Counter (OTC) Medications (Advil, Tylenol, etc.). The permission form is not available online. Contact the Nurse if you need a copy of the form. OTC medication must be in the original container. Please send the smallest bottle available, storage space in the clinic is limited. Please see handbook for additional information.

General Information

After School Care Program

St. Monica offers an optional After School Care Program on days when school is in session except for the last day of school. The After School Care Program is offered at an additional cost to students who are registered in St. Monica After School Care Program for Pre-K through 8th grades. Drop-in care is not available and families must register each student that will be using the program. There is a \$25 registration fee per student. 
Safe Environment




