



Summer Reading Assignment

Rising 2nd grade: Please choose Two (2) Books to read over the summer.

Rising 3rd Grade: Please choose a total of three (3) books to read before returning to school in the fall. The books must be from different authors / series.

Rising 4th Grade: Students must read a total of two (2) books before returning to school this fall. Students may choose any title from the authors listed below.

Rising 5th Grade: Students are required to read one novel during the summer in preparation for the school year. Reading is due the first day of school, and the students are expected to bring a copy of the novel to class with them. Students are required to annotate their summer novel. Annotations can be made in the novel or in a separate notebook that the student will bring with them on the first day of school. The selected novel is part of the English-Language Arts curriculum and will be used in class during the first week(s) of school. Students will have in-class discussions, assignments, and/or assessments on the reading.

Rising 6th Grade: Students are required to read one novel during the summer in preparation for the school year. Reading is due the first day of school, and the students are expected to bring a copy of the novel to class with them. Students are required to annotate their summer novel. Annotations include notes in the margins as well as end-of-chapter notes. All annotations should be made in the novel - not on index cards, notebook paper, etc. The selected novel is part of the English-Language Arts curriculum and will be used in class during the first week(s) of school.
