1. When will 2019-2020 applications be available?

Application will be available starting October 1, 2018 and is due February 1, 2019.

3. Does the school provide Tuition Assistance?

4. What is the maximum class size?

Part time 4 yr olds – 8 students

Full time 4 yr olds & Developmental Kindergarten – 18 students

Kindergarten – 4th grade, classrooms of 20 maximum, 80 students per grade

1st -8th grade - 4 classrooms of 25 maximum, 100 students per grade

5. At what age is my child eligible for St. Monica?

4's class – must be 4 by September 1 and potty trained

DK – must be 5 by December 31

K – must be 5 by September 1

1st – must be 6 by September 1

6. Do we need to be catholic to attend St. Monica?

No, we welcome all students to apply and attend St. Monica

7. Do St. Monica students attend Mass?

Yes K-4 attend mass every Tuesday morning at 8 am, 5-8 attend mass every Friday at 8 am. First Friday of each month is an all school mass. We welcome parents to join us.
